A Proclamation for "Purple Heart Violet Days in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, The Purple Heart is the emblematic decoration given to those in the armed forces who have received injury while engaged in battle, and the Military Order of the Purple Heart includes only those persons who have been awarded the Purple Heart Medal; and

WHEREAS, Our Military Order of the Purple Heart uses also a fine sum of money for the sale of Purple Heart violet, and the proceeds of the product are used for the welfare, rehabilitation, and relief of needy and deserving veterans and their families and

WHEREAS, The Department of Minnesota of the Military Order of the Purple Heart is participating in this campaign to enable our veterans

PROCLAIMED, I, LUTHER J. MANGOLD, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 8 to 9, 1951, as

"PURPLE HEART VIOLET DAYS IN MINNESOTA"

and urge all citizens to join in this annual observance sponsored by the Military Order of the Purple Heart.

IN FAITH WHEREBY, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this nineteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one and of the State of Minnesota, one ninety-fourth.
