A Proclamation for "National Vegetable Week"

WHEREAS, the Vegetable Growers Association of America is sponsoring its second annual "National Vegetable Week", beginning August 5, 1951, and

WHEREAS, the national health and welfare is in a great measure dependent upon the year-round production of an abundance of vegetables and

WHEREAS, the 766,000 vegetable growers of the United States are engaged in a cooperative effort in the production of a finer quality and greater variety of this staple and necessary food; and

WHEREAS, during its 43 years the Vegetable Growers Association of America has given leadership to the improvement of vegetables and their production in greater abundance; and

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota has earned a reputation for the outstanding quality of its vegetables and has many market gardeners who are members of the Vegetable Growers Association of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of August 5 to 11, 1951 as

"NATIONAL VEGETABLE WEEK"

in recognition of the importance of the vegetable growing industry in Minnesota and the nation and the continuance of research in the production, marketing and transporting of vegetables.
