A Proclamation for "Minnesota Truck Safety Week"

WHEREAS, the motor transport industry of Minnesota, being fully aware of its responsibility to work for safety on our highways, will hold the seventh annual Minnesota Truck Roadeo at the State Fair Grounds, beginning at 1:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 16; and

WHEREAS, the trucking industry has invited the people of Minnesota to attend this show, without charge, and watch expert truck drivers compete in contests designed to encourage safety among professional truck drivers; and

WHEREAS, these drivers have demonstrated their proficiency by maintaining accident-free records over Minnesota highways for the past 12 months; and

WHEREAS, the winners of this competition will represent Minnesota in the National Truck Roadeo in Chicago, Illinois, October 22-26;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week, beginning September 16, 1951, as

"MINNESOTA TRUCK SAFETY WEEK"

In recognition of the important contribution of the Truck Roadeo to the highway safety education program of the state.
