A Proclamation for "Babe Ruth Day"

WHEREAS, Thursday, August 16th, is the third anniversary of the death of Babe Ruth; and

WHEREAS, on that day, the Babe Ruth Foundation, organized to continue Babe Ruth's help to underprivileged children, will sponsor a series of special programs to perpetuate the memory of Babe Ruth as an outstanding example of true American sportsmanship and achievement; and

WHEREAS, this effort is devoted to providing funds for continuance of the foundation's sportsmanship program among the youth of America and for the American Cancer Society's battle against the disease that killed Babe Ruth;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, August 16, 1951, as

"BABE RUTH DAY"

in honor of one of the greatest baseball heroes of all time, and in support of the noble work being carried on by the Babe Ruth Foundation.
