## PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF SPRING PARK

TO YELL BOARD OF COURTY COMMISSIONARS OF HEMBERIN COURTY, HINDROTA:

and residents of the territory hereinafter described who have resided continuously within the territory proposed to be incorporated for at least two years prior to the date of this petition, and being at least twenty-five in number, do hereby petition and request the Board of County Commissioners of Hennepin County, Minnesota, to call an election, fixing the time and place therefor, for the determination of whether or not the land embraced within the boundaries set forth below shall be incorporated as a village, pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Laws of 1949 of the State of Hinnesota.
