A Proclamation for "Junior Achievement Week"

WHEREAS, Junior Achievement is a national program to give high school young people an opportunity to establish miniature companies and thereby gain valuable experience in business ownership and management; and

WHEREAS, Junior Achievement members carry out the keynote of their organization, "Learn by doing," gaining confidence and incentive -- basic ingredients for success in the American business system; and

WHEREAS, the Junior Achievement Program provides means for young people to compete for scholarships and educational trips and to participate in wholesome recreation activities, in addition to earning profits in their businesses;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week, beginning September 9, as

and urge all business leaders and citizens to support and encourage the activities of Junior Achievement, Inc., in which 75,000 teen-agers are now members including many in our own state.
