A Proclamation for "Parent-Teacher Enrollment Month in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, in the strengthening of democracy, no responsibility of its citizens is greater than that of providing equal opportunities for the education of youth; and

WHEREAS, for over a quarter of a century the parent-teacher associations in the communities of Minnesota have brought together adults interested in the welfare of children and youth and in the betterment of the local schools; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers now has a membership of 100,000 working for youth; and

WHEREAS, the month of October has been designated as a time for enrolling our members for the 1951-52 parent-teacher year and the goal is an increase of 10,000 in membership;

I, WALTER S. SAUNDERS, GOVERNOR OF MINNESOTA, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1951, as

"PARENT-TEACHER ENROLLMENT MONTH IN MINNESOTA"

and urge all citizens to consider the outstanding programs being carried on by our parent-teacher associations and to help our state and nation prepare for the future by joining in this activity so beneficial to the children of this state.
