A Proclamation for "Young-Teacher Personnel Week in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, in the strengthening of community, no responsibility of the citizen is greater than that of providing equal opportunity for the education of youth; and

WHEREAS, for over a quarter of a century the general teacher associations in the communities of Minnesota have brought together adults interested in the welfare of children and youth and in the betterment of the local schools; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota League of Parents and Teachers now has a membership of 100,000 members; for youth and

WHEREAS, the work of teacher has been emphasized on a time for enrolling new students for the 1949-50 school year and the goal to be informed of 100,000 in membership.

Now, therefore, I, EUGENE T. VOLWILER, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October, 1950, as

"Young-Teacher Personnel Week in Minnesota"

and urge all citizens to consider the educational progress being carried on by our public-schools' institutions and to help our state and nation prepare for the future by giving to this activity an interest equal to the interests of this state.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol, St. Paul, day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, the day of the birth of George Washington.
