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# PETITION FOR THE INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKELAND

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, STATE OF MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, being twenty-five or more, voters residing in the territory hereinafter described, and proposed to be incorporated as a village, and situated in the Townships of West Lakeland and Lakeland, in the County of Washington, State of Minnesota, do hereby respectfully petition your Honorable Board and allege:

- (1) That all of your petitioners are legal voters of and in the territory hereinafter described and reside in said territory and have resided therein continuously for at least two years prior to the date of this petition.
- (2) That the said territory for the incorporation of which as a village this petition is made is contained within the following boundaries:

Beginning at a point where the South line of Lot One (1), Section Eleven (11), Township Twenty-eight (28) North of Range Twenty (20) West intersects the west shore of the St. Croix River; running thence West along the South line of said Lot One (1) and the South line of the North Half of the Northwest Quarter ( $N_2^{\perp}$  of  $NW_2^{\perp}$ ) of said Section Eleven (11) to the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NWZ of NWZ) of said Section Eleven (11); thence North along the section line between Sections Ten (10) and Eleven (11), and between Sections Two (2) and Three (3), Township Twenty-eight (28) North of Range Twenty (20) West and between Sections Thirty-four (34) and Thirty-five (35), and between Sections Twenty-six (26) and Twentyseven (27), Township Twenty-nine (29) North of Range Twenty (20) West to the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW of NW) of said Section Twentysix (26); thence East along the South line of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW of NW) of said Section Twenty-six (26) and the South line of Lot One (1) of said Section Twenty-six (26) to the West shore of the St. Croix River; thence Southerly along the west shore of the St. Croix River to the point of beginning; excepting therefrom that part thereof included within the corporate limits of the Village of Lakeland Shores; all of the above described property being situated in Lakeland Township, Washington County, Minnesota, and in West Lakeland Township, Washington County, Minnesota.

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- (3) That said territory contains 1300 acres more or less, being larger than one section and less than a full township in area; that the average population of the area exceeds 100 persons for each section in the area.
- (4) That a part of the territory embraced within said boundaries has been platted into lots and blocks in the manner provided by law and that the remainder of said territory consists of unplatted lands adjoining the platted area; that the assessed valuation of the platted lands in said area exceeds 50 percent of the total assessed valuation in such area; that all of said territory, platted and unplatted, is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.
- (5) That attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof is a map marked "Exhibit A" of that portions of the said Towns of West Lakeland and Lakeland containing the territory above described; that the portion of said Towns of West Lakeland and Lakeland marked in red is the territory above described and purposed to be incorporated; that the platted portion of said territory is shaded.
- (6) That no part of said territory is included within the limits of any incorporated municipality.
- (7) That said territory above described contains a resident population of more than 100 persons; that attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof is a census list marked "Exhibit B" showing the buildings in the area used for residences and the number of people living in each; that said census was begun on August 20, 1951, and completed on August 24, 1951; that as shown by said census list the territory contains a resident population of 479; that said census was taken and said census list compiled by George Clymer, Lawrence P. Crocker, and Lorenz Lindstrom; that all three are voters residing within said territory; that all three are signers of this petition and have verified the same.
- (8) That the name which is purposed to be given to the said territory which is hereby purposed to be incorporated is the "Village of Lakeland".
- (9) That this petition is made for the purpose of having an election held to determine whether or not the said territory shall be incorporated as a village under the name aforesaid.

#### WHEREWORE, Your petitioners pray:

- 1. That your Honorable Board approve said petition and that it fix a time and place for holding an election within said territory at which the question of the proposed incorporation of the said territory as a village be submitted and voted upon.
- 2. That it cause notice of said election to be published and posted according to law, and cause ballots to be prepared and three inspectors of election to be appointed who shall act as judges of said election, and that your Honorable Board take such other steps and proceedings as the law requires, to the end that it may be determined whether or not said territory shall be incorporated.
