TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said office of JUDGE OF PROBATE COURT together with all the rights, powers, and emoluments to the said office belonging, or by law in anywise appertaining, until this commission shall be by me or other lawful authority, superseded or annulled, or expire by force or reason of any law of this State.
