NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. ELMER ANDERSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 15 to 21, 1951, as

and urge all citizens to note this observation by turning to the Bible and reading the spiritual and moral message which it has for all humanity.
