A Proclamation for "Apple Week"

WHEREAS, apple growers in this state have devoted much time and effort toward producing apples that can grow in Minnesota and which can match and surpass the qualities of apples grown in other areas of our nation;

Now, THEREFORE, I, G. Elmer Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do proclaim the week of October 23 to November 2, 1951 as
