A Proclamation for "Israel Bond Month"

WHEREAS, the State of Israel is a vital and developing democracy in the strategic area of the Middle East; and

WHEREAS, the flow of immigration into Israel at the rate of 17,000 persons per month places a severe strain upon the resources of that small nation; and

WHEREAS, the success of the \$500,000,000 Independence Bond Issue by the State of Israel is essential for the expansion of industry and agriculture needed to absorb the unprecedented immigration; and

WHEREAS, the people of Minnesota have always identified themselves with the democratic aims and aspirations of the State of Israel;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, G. Elmer Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period beginning November 1, 1951, and ending December 1, 1951, as

"ISRAEL BOND MONTH"

and urge full support to the State of Israel Independence Bond Issue to insure the successful completion of that nation's National Development Plan.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this Thirty-first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one and of the state, the ninety-fourth.
