

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. BURNQUIST, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby constitute and appoint PHILIP J. MACKEY of St. Paul, Minnesota, to act without compensation as Special Assistant Attorney General for the state in the matter of bringing such actions to determine adverse title or proceedings in registration of titles as may be necessary to determine that the State of Minnesota is the owner in fee simple, free and clear of encumbrances, of the lands located in Aitkin County, Minnesota, described with the taconite lease from the state thereon as follows:



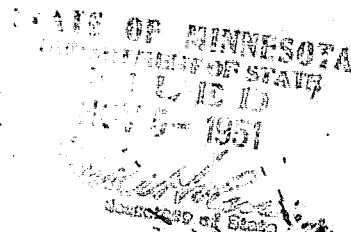
