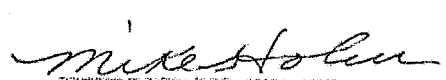

- WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota, in order to provide for the work of October 20 to 27, 1911, as

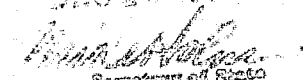
