PLAN A OF VILLAGE GOVERNMENT


TO MIKE HOLM, SECRETARY OF STATE, STATE OF MINNESOTA:

I, Walter B. Rae, Clerk of the Village of Dilworth, Clay County, Minnesota, do hereby certify that at the general election held in the Village of Dilworth on December 4th, 1951, the following question was submitted to the voters of the village:


"Shall Optional Plan A, modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village?"

I further certify that the affirmative votes on the foregoing proposition were 138 and the negative votes were 60 and that the question of adoption of Optional Plan A received an affirmative majority of the votes cast on the question.
