

An Ordinance to annex to the
Village of Long Lake, Minnesota,
Certain Territory abutting on
said Village

The Village Council of the Village of Long Lake, Hennepin
County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

The following described unplatted land, to-wit:

That part of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of
Section Thirty-four (34) Township One Hundred Eighteen
(118) North of Range Twenty-three (23) West of the 6th
Principal Meridian, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast (SE) corner of
the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-four (34)
in Township One Hundred Eighteen (118) North of Range
Twenty-three (23) West; thence West on the section line
twenty-five and seventy one-hundredths (25.70) chains;
thence North Seventeen and seventy one-hundredths (17.70)
chains, to the satertown road heretofore vacated; thence
Northeast (NE'y) along said road as formerly laid out
and established, and the south side of the Townsite of
Long Lake to the salish road; thence Southeast (SE'y)
along the salish road to the East (E) line of said quarter
section; thence South twenty-six and fifty one-hundredths
(26.50) chains to the place of the beginning, according
to the United States Government survey thereof; said
property being otherwise described as "Subdivision No. 1
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Subdivision No. 1 SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and Subdivision
No. 1 of lot 3 Section 34, Township 118, Range 23 of
T. 1. Smith's land"; excepting, however, therefrom, a
tract of land containing eighteen and eighty-seven
one-hundredths (18.87) acres, more or less, conveyed by
Vellie A. Hubachek and husband to Mary E. Brackett, by
deed dated May 14, 1916 and recorded in the office of the
Register of Deeds in and for Hennepin County, Minnesota,
on May 26, 1916 in Book 334 of Deeds on pages 416 et. seq.,
which excepted tract is described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the
Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section, lying south
of a line described as follows:- beginning at a point
in the east line of said Section Thirty-four (34) which
point is three hundred forty (340) feet south (S) of
the Northeast (NE) corner of said Southeast quarter of
the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section;
thence running Southwest (SW), making an angle to the
right of thirty-six (36) degrees and forty-five (45)
minutes from said East line of said Section, a distance

of Two hundred twenty (220) feet to the center line of the bed of the creek which flows from Long Lake (in said Town of Orono) Southwesterly, into Mud Lake near Lake Minnetonka; thence following the center line of the bed of said creek in a Westerly and Southwesterly direction to a point in the center line of said creek One hundred eighty (180) feet Northeastly from the Southwest corner of said quarter quarter section; thence in a straight line Southwesterly to said Southwest corner;

the land above described, less said excepted tract, containing forty and five one-hundredths (40.05) acres, more or less;

be and the same hereby is declared to be annexed to the Village of Long Lake, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Upon the filing of a certified copy of this Ordinance in the office of the County Auditor of Hennepin County, Minnesota, and in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, the annexation shall be complete and the land shall become part of the Village of Long Lake as effectual as if it had been originally a part of said Village.
