PETITION FOR INCORPORATION
OF PROPOSED VILLAGE OF LAKE SAINT CROIX BEACH

TO: The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Washington,
Minnesota:

We, the undersigned, residents of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your Honorble board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters within said territory may vote on the question of incorporating the same as a village, and for that purpose respectfully state:

1. All of your petitioners are legal voters and residents within the territory hereinafter described, and each has resided continuously within said territory for at least two years prior to the date of this petition.
2. None of the territory hereinabove described is now a part of any incorporated city or village.
3. The territory which it is proposed to incorporate consists partly of land which have been platted into lots and blocks, which plats have been duly and legally made and certified according to the laws of this state and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Washington, Minnesota, and partly of unplatated land which adjoin the platted area and are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government. All of said lands, platted and unplattd, lie entirely within the town of Aitkin in the County of Washington, Minnesota, and the boundaries of the foregoing lands herein proposed to be incorporated are as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot No. 2101, Lake Saint Croix Beach, Section No. 1, thence east to the west shore of Lake Saint Croix, to the point of beginning; thence westerly to the Southwest corner of Lot No. 2101, Lake Saint Croix Beach, Section No. 1; thence westerly to the Southwest corner of Lot No. 2039,

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION
OF PROPOSED VILLAGE OF LAKE SAINT CROIX BEACH

TO: The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Washington,
Minnesota:

We, the undersigned, residents of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters within said territory may vote on the question of incorporating the same as a village, and for that purpose respectfully state:

1. All of your petitioners are legal voters and residents within the territory hereinafter described, and each has resided continuously within said territory for at least two years prior to the date of this petition.
2. None of the territory hereinafter described is now a part of any incorporated city or village.
3. The territory which it is proposed to incorporate consists partly of lands which have been platted into lots and blocks, which plats have been duly and legally made and certified according to the laws of this state and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Washington, Minnesota, and partly of unplatte lands which adjoin the platted area and are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government. All of said lands, platted and unplatte, lie entirely within the Town of Afton in the County of Washington, Minnesota, and the boundaries of the foregoing lands herein proposed to be incorporated are as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot No. 2101, Lake Saint Croix Beach, Section No. 1, thence west to the West Shore of Lake Saint Croix, to the point of beginning;

Commencing at the West shore of Lake Saint Croix, thence westerly to the Southeast corner of Lot No. 2101, Lake Saint Croix Beach, Section No. 1; thence westerly to the Southwest corner of Lot No. 2089,

5. The foregoing lands, both platted and unplatteu, and bounded as above described, contain a resident population of 471 persons, as ascertained by a census which was commenced on the 29th day of Oct , 1951, and completed on the 21st day of Nov. , 1951, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, marked "Exhibit A", showing the buildings in the area used for residences and the number of people living in each.
6. That attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof is a map marked, "Exhibit B", of that portion of said Town of Afton containing the territory hereinbefore described; that the portion of said town of Afton enclosed by "red" lines is the territory above described and proposed to be incorporated.

7. The name of the village proposed to be incorporated is the "Village of Lake Saint Croix Beach" Minnesota.
8. That this petition is made for the purpose of instituting legal proceedings to incorporate said village and for the purpose of having an election held to determine whether or not said territory shall be incorporated as a village under the name aforesaid.

WHEREFORE, Your petitioners pray:

1. That your Honorable Board approve said petition and that it fix a time and place for holding an election within said territory at which the question of the proposed incorporation of the said territory as a village be submitted and voted upon.
2. That it cause notice of said election to be published and posted according to law, and cause ballots to be prepared and three inspectors of election to be appointed who shall act as judges of said election, and that your Honorable board take such other steps and proceedings as the law requires, to the end that it may be determined whether or not said territory shall be incorporated.


