

Affidavit of Publication

.....Henry Knipp....., being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher of the newspaper known as Le Center Leader, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated, that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the Village of Le Center, in the County of Le Sueur, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the Village of Le Center from which it purports to be issued as above stated in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to a page, each sixteen inches long; has been issued Thursday of each week from a known office established in said place of publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that during said time in its make-up not less than twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; that it has been circulated in and near said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and had entry as second class matter in its local postoffice; and that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Le Sueur County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper

That the Ordinance hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for one successive weeks; that it was first so published on Thursday, the .. 20. day of December....., 19.51., and thereafter on Thursday of each week to and including the day of 19.....; and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 118
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF SAID VILLAGE OF LE CENTER, MINNESOTA, SO AS TO INCLUDE IN SAID VILLAGE THE LANDS BELOW DESCRIBED, AND MAKING SAID LANDS A PART OF SAID VILLAGE.

The Village Council of Le Center, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described lands, to-wit:
 Lots Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), and Eight (8),
 Block Two (2), Hobday's Addition to the Village of Le Center, Le Sueur County, Minnesota,
 lies adjacent to and joins said Village.

Section 2. That the boundary lines of said Village of Le Center, Minnesota, are hereby enlarged to cover said above lands together with any adjoining streets and alleys.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
