

ORDINANCE NO. 17.

An Ordinance to annex certain territory to the Village of Kellogg, Wabasha County, State of Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Kellogg do ordain.

SECTION, 1. Whereas, that portion of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Twenty Two (22) Township No. One Hundred Ten (110) North of Range Ten (10) West, lying and being Southerly of the Zumbro River, in said County, do constitute unplatted land, and not exceeding Two Hundred acres, abutting upon the limits of said village; and whereas, a majority of the owners of the said portion of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Twenty Two (22) Township No. One Hundred Ten (110) North of Range Ten (10) West, lying and being Southerly of the Zumbro River in said County, have petitioned the Village Council of ~~the Village of Kellogg~~ said Village to have such land included within said Village of Kellogg.

Now, Therefore, said portion of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Twenty Two (22) Township No. One Hundred Ten (110) North of Range Ten (10) West, are hereby annexed to said Village of Kellogg and the boundaries of said village of Kellogg, are hereby extended so as to include the same.

SECTION, 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage and publication.
