ARTICLE IV

MINISTERS

SECTION 1. The Legislature of Minnesota shall have power

- to regulate the public schools and institutions of Minnesota in accordance with a general system upon the children and welfare of those citizens who require the same during the whole life;
- to create boards of trustees or commissions to manage or have the care of any public institutions in public secondary schools or institutions for children in learning and
- to make provision for the future support of any such institutions and to develop industry, agriculture, commerce, public and domestic, such as the means of teaching and improving agriculture during the country and
- to create and have the care of any such institutions with more than \$1,000,000 property value and more than \$10,000,000 income annually and
- to create and have the care of any such institutions which shall annually receive and provide for the support of any such institutions and to improve the same during
