A Proclamation for "School Safety Patrol Week"

- WHEREAS, these young members of the School Safety Patrols endure the discomfort of inclement weather and many other inconveniences in order to fulfill their assignments with courage and loyalty; and
- WHEREAS, since the School Safety Patrols have discharged their duty so effectively that not one child under their care has died as a result of a traffic accident; and
- WHEREAS, it is fitting that we should set aside a special week to pay tribute to the boys and girls who faithfully give a great amount of time and energy to the School Safety Patrol instead of to play and recreation; and
- WHEREAS, the various community and civic organizations which sponsor and aid the Safety Patrol deserve high commendation for the contribution they are making to the program;

BEFORE ME, J. C. LEONARD, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 27 through 29 as

"SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL WEEK"

as a means of recognizing and encouraging the important work of the School Safety Patrol in Minnesota, and as a means whereby the sponsoring groups of the School Safety Patrol program can focus attention on the remarkable record set in not having lost a life.
