

ORDINANCE NO. 147

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS UNDER 200 ACRES IN AREA TO THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID VILLAGE TO INCLUDE THE LANDS DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND DECLARING SUCH LANDS ANNEXED TO THE VILLAGE.

The Village Council of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE. That the unplatted lands hereinafter described, being less than two hundred (200) acres in area and abutting upon the present Village limits of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, be annexed to said Village and that the Village boundaries be extended to include these lands.

SECTION TWO. That said area ~~is~~ be annexed and the description of said lands are as follows; to-wit: That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Fifty-five (55) North, Range Twenty-five (25), which lies East of a line which is parallel with and distant Five Hundred Eighty-one feet (581') West of the East boundary line of said Northeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$), and the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Government Lot numbered Two (2) and all of Government Lot numbered Three (3) in Section Twenty-eight (28) Township Fifty-five (55), North of Range Twenty-five (25), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

SECTION THREE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage according to law.
