

ORDINANCE NO. 5

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Unplatted Territory to the Village of Borup:

The Village Council of the Village of Borup do ordain as follows:

SEC. 1. That the following described unplatted area, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the village limits of the Village of Borup, Minnesota, thence West four hundred seventy-two feet (W 472 ft); thence South two thousand six hundred forty feet (S 2640 ft); thence East four hundred seventy-two feet (E 472 ft); thence North two thousand six hundred forty feet (N 2640 ft) along the West line of the Village to the place of beginning,

abutting upon and adjacent to the incorporated Village of Borup, be and the same is hereby annexed to such Village and shall become a part of such Village as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.
