, therefore I have
in virtue of the power granted to me by the Government
of Finland, nominated and appointed

Mr. Alex Kytykyner

to this office and pray everyone and especially the
authorities in his district to grant him their benevolence
and confidence and all necessary assistance in the
exercise of his functions as well as the rights and privileges
that pertain to his office and are conceded to Consuls
of other Powers.
