to this office and pray everyone and especially the authorities in his district to grant him their benevolence and confidence and all necessary assistance in the exercise of his functions as well as the rights and privileges that pertain to his office and are conceded to Consuls of other Powers.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

I Certify That, satisfactory evidence having been exhibited of the appointment of Alex. Kyjshkyren as Consul of Finland with an honorary status at Luluth, Minnesota, for the State of Minnesota, — the President of the United States of America has ordered his recognition as such officer, declaring him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and privileges as are allowed to the honorary Consuls of the most favored Nations in the United States.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Dean Acheson, Secretary of State of the United States of America, have hereinto subscribed my name and caused the Seal of the Department of State to be affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this ninth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, and the 176th year of the Independence of the United States of America.
