I Certify That satisfactory evidence having been exhibited of the appointment of  
*Mrs. Lilian Study* as British Vice Consul at Minneapolis and  
*St. Paul, Minnesota,* the President of the United States of America has ordered  
her recognition as such officer, declaring her free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and  
privileges as are allowed to Vice Consuls by the law of Nations, or by the laws of the United States and  
existing treaty stipulations between the Government of Great Britain and the United States.

of the United States of America, have hereunto subscribed my name and caused the Seal of the  
Department of State to be affixed.
