To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

I Certify That satisfactory evidence having been exhibited of the appointment of
Mrs. William Stultz as British Vice Consul at Minneapolis and
St. Paul, Minnesota, the President of the United States of America has ordered
her recognition as such officer, declaring her free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers and
privileges as are allowed to Vice Consuls by the law of Nations or by the laws of the United States and
existing treaty stipulations between the Government of Great Britain and the United States.

Department of State to be affixed.
