PETITION FOR THE INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE
OF
QUAMBA, MINNESOTA

TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF KANABEC COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

The undersigned voters, who have resided within the territory hereinafter described, continuously for a period of at least two years prior to the date hereof, hereby petition the County Board of Kanabec County, Minnesota to call an election within said territory for the determination of the incorporation of said territory into a Village and for that purpose state as follows:

1. That said petitioners did on the 28th day of March, 1952, cause a census of the resident population of said territory to be taken by Carl Johnson and Emil Oslin who reside within said territory and it was found that on said date there was a resident population in said territory of 101 persons.

2. That the boundary of the territory to be so incorporated consists of the following platted portions within said territory and known as:

Flat of Quamba, also known as Original Town of Quamba and being part of E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 40, Range 23 of Kanabec County, Minnesota,

P. H. Peterson's Addition to Quamba, Minnesota and being a part of S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 40, Range 23 of Kanabec County, Minnesota,

O'Berg and Lundquist's Addition to Quamba, Minnesota and being a part of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 40, Range 23 of Kanabec County, Minnesota,

which said platted portions have been platted into lots and blocks and duly and legally certified according to the Laws of the State of Minnesota and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Kanabec

County, Minnesota, also all the land adjacent to said plats and lying wholly within the following territory, to-wit:

1. That an election was duly held on the 7th day of July, 1952, at and between the hours of 12 o'clock noon and 8:00 o'clock P. 


VILLAGE OF QUAMBA INCORPORATION PLAT
