ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDAKIES

The Village Council of the Village of Foley, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

See Affet

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Foley are hereby extended so as to include the following described parcels of land abutting upon said village, to-wit:

(a) Beginning at the point of intersection of the southerly line of Main Street in the Village of Foley and the easterly line of a public highway runnine on the west line of the Northeast Quarter (NEZ) of Section Thirty-five (35); thence northeasterly along said southerly line of said Main Street to its intersection with the South line of Section Twenty-six (26); thence easterly along said south line of Section Twenty-six (26) to its intersection with the moutherly line of the Great Northern Hailway right of way; thence southwesterly along said southerly line of said right of way; to its intersection with the west line of said public highway running along said westlline of said Northeast Quarter (NEZ) of Section Thirty-five (35); thence north on said west line of said public highway to the place of beginning; all being in Township Thirty-seven (37) North of Hange Twenty-nine (29) West in Benton County, Minnesota, which is of record in the name of Great Northern Railway Company, a corporation;

Also the following described lands in Holdgidge Addition to the Village of Foley, to-wit:

(b) The North Half $(N_{2}^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of Lot Eleven (11), all of Lot Twelve (12), and the South Half $(S_{2}^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of Hot Thirteen (13), all in Block Seven (7), which is of record in the names of Edward P. Lagergren and Ina L. Lagergren, husband and wife, as joint tenants;

(c) All of Lots One (1), Two (2), and Three (3) and the bouth Half (S_{Ξ}^{1}) of Lot Four (4) in Block Seven (7), which is of record in the names of Gladys Kotsmith and William E. Kotsmith, as joint tenants;

(d) The South Half (S_2^{\pm}) of Lot Eleven (11) in Block Seven (7), which is of record in the names of Vego G. Larson, Jr. and Dorothy M. Larson, husband and wife, as joint tenants;

(e) Lots Sixteen (16) and Seventeen (17) in Block Three (3) which is of record in the name of Sylvester J. Tomperowski;
