

ORDINANCE NO. 76

An Ordinance extending the village boundaries of the Village of Twin Valley
The Village Council of Twin Valley do ordain as follows:

SECTION I- That the petition of Emil and Marie Lien requesting that the following described property adjoining and abutting the village limits of the Village of Twin Valley be included in the Village Limits of Twin Valley be and hereby is granted. The land involved is the following parcel:

Beginning at a point twenty (20) feet North of a point Three hundred eighty-two (382) feet West of the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One hundred forty-four (144) Range Forty-four (44) thence West one hundred (100) feet, thence North One hundred fifty (150) feet, thence East One hundred (100) feet thence South One hundred fifty (150) feet to place of beginning.

SECTION II- The Village Limits of said Village of Twin Valley are hereby extended to include the above described real estate.

SECTION III- This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publications and filing a certified copy of said ordinance with the Secretary of State.
