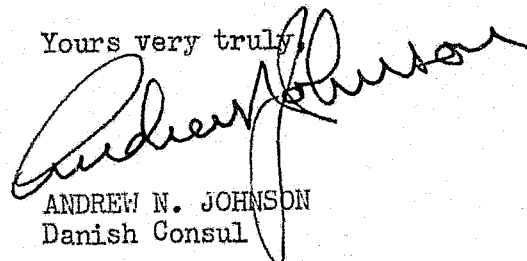

*Done at the City of Washington this fifteenth day of September,
in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty, and of the
Independence of the United States of America, the one hundred and seventy-fifth.*
