

ORDINANCE NO. 248
ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN
PROPERTY ABUTTING THE CITY
OF ANOKA, TO THE CITY
OF ANOKA

The City Commission of the City of Anoka do ordain:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to a proper and sufficient petition by the owner of a tract, piece and parcel of land abutting the City of Anoka, Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the West twenty-three (23) acres of all that part of the East half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Six (6), Township Thirty-one (31), Range Twenty-four (24), lying on the Southerly side of the railroad right-of-way as same now crosses said tract; thence running North Two (2) rods to the place of beginning; thence North Thirty-two (32) rods; thence East Twenty (20) rods; thence South Thirty-two (32) rods; thence West Twenty (20) rods to the point of commencement, all of said land being in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota.

to have said property annexed to the City of Anoka, said tract, piece and parcel of land is hereby declared an addition to the City of Anoka.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect after its passage and publication according to law.
