Writ of election providing for filling the vacancy in the office of State Representative from the twelfth legislative district of the state at a special election on December 16, 1952, and providing for the nomination of candidates for said vacancy at a special primary election to be held on December 2, 1952.

To the people of the State of Minnesota, and particularly of the twelfth legislative district of said state, to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, to the County Auditor of the County of Murray in said state, and to all election officers in said district and of all of the several election districts therein, and to all others whom it may concern:


Whereas a vacancy now exists in the office of State Representative from the twelfth district of the State of Minnesota caused by the death of the Honorable Trigg N. Knutson; and

WHEREAS there will be occasion for the person elected to fill said vacancy to take office and to exercise the functions thereof at the next regular session of the state legislature:


NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. ELMER ANDERSON, AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, acting under the authority and direction of Section 17 of Article IV of the Minnesota Constitution and the statutes in such case made and provided, do hereby direct that said vacancy be filled at the special election to be held in said district on December 16, 1952, and that candidates for said office be nominated at a special primary election to be held in said district on Tuesday, December 2, 1952; that affidavits of candidacy for nomination at said primary may be filed from this day until the 25th day of November at 5:00 p.m. 1952, both dates inclusive; that notices of said primary election and the said election thereafter be given, posted and published as prescribed by law; and that the nomination and election of candidates and the conduct of said elections be had, and all things pertaining thereto be done, as provided in Sections 205.05 to 205.17, Minnesota Statutes 1949, and other applicable provisions of law.


