

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION OF
OPTIONAL PLAN OF VILLAGE
GOVERNMENT

TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND COUNTY AUDITOR OF THE
COUNTY OF FILLMORE:

I, Oliver H. Blekre, clerk of the village of
Lanesboro, do hereby certify that at the general election
held in the said village on the 4th day of November,
1952, the following question was submitted to the voters
of the village:

"Shall Optional Plan A, modifying the standard
plan of village government by providing for the appoint-
ment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor,
be adopted for the government of the village?"

I further certify that the affirmative votes
cast on the foregoing proposition were 344 and the
negative votes were 213, and the question of adoption of
Optional Plan A received an affirmative majority of the
votes cast on the question.
