BURNQUIST, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 8.06, and the written request of the Commissioner of Taxation, do hereby constitute and appoint GEORGE L. POWELL, of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Taxation, for the period commencing December 1, 1952, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and, on the recommendation of said department, I hereby fix the compensation of said George L. Powell as such Special Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Taxation at the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) per year, to be paid from the appropriation made for the Department of Taxation.
