

C E R T I F I C A T E  
OF THE VOTE OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS  
STATE OF MINNESOTA

We, the undersigned, electors of President and Vice President of the United States of America, for the respective terms beginning on the Twentieth day of January, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-three, being electors duly and legally elected, appointed and qualified by and for the State of Minnesota, as appears by the annexed list of electors, made, certified and delivered to us by the Governor of the State of Minnesota, having met and convened at the Capitol in the City of St. Paul in the State of Minnesota, and in conformity with the laws and the constitution of the United States, on the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December next following our appointment, being the fifteenth day of December, A.D. 1952.

DO HEREBY CERTIFY, That, being so assembled and duly organized, we proceeded to vote by ballot, and balloted first for President and then for Vice President, by distinct ballots;

AND WE FURTHER CERTIFY, That the following are two distinct lists: one, of the votes for President; and the other, of the votes for Vice President; so cast as aforesaid:




