
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. BURNQUIST, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 8.06, and the written request of the Commissioner of Taxation, do hereby constitute and appoint JOSEPH S. ABDNOR of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Taxation, for the period commencing January 5, 1953, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and on the recommendation of said department I hereby fix the compensation of said JOSEPH S. ABDNOR as such Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Taxation at the sum of Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$8,775) per year, to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of Taxation.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 27<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1952.




