

ORDINANCE NO. 64

An Ordinance Extending the village boundaries of the Village of Chisholm so as to include the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of section sixteen (16), Township fifty-eight (58), north, Range twenty (20), west in St. Louis County, Minnesota, and the westerly part of said Southeast (SE 1/4) of section (16), Township fifty-eight (58), north Range twenty (20), west, the same being the plat of Carlin, said plat being of record in the office of register of Deeds in an for St. Louis County.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHISHOLM DO ORDIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The majority of the owners of the plat known as the Plat of Carlin, which is on record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for St. Louis County, said Plat covering the westerly part of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Sixteen (16) Township Fifty-eight (58), North, Range Twenty (20), West, and the majority of the owners of the balance of the forty acre tract, described as the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Fifty-eight (58), North, Range, Twenty (20), West, St. Louis County, Minnesota, which land abuts upon the Village of Chisholm, having petitioned the Village Council of the Village of Chisholm to have said land included within said Village it is ordained that the village boundaries of the Village of Chisholm, be, and they are hereby so extended as to include the said land within such boundaries.

SECTION TWO. A copy of this ordinance shall be forthwith certified by the proper Village officers and filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota. And a certified copy of same be filed with the register of deeds of St. Louis County for record.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 64.

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHISHOLM SO AS TO INCLUDE THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER (S E $\frac{1}{4}$) OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (S W $\frac{1}{4}$) OF SECTION SIXTEEN (16) , TOWNSHIP FIFTY EIGHT (58) , NORTH , RANGE TWENTY (20) , WEST , IN ST. LOUIS COUNTY , MINNESOTA , AND THE WESTERLY PART OF SAID SOUTHEAST QUARTER (S E $\frac{1}{4}$) OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (S W $\frac{1}{4}$) OF SECTION SIXTEEN (16) , TOWNSHIP FIFTY-EIGHT (58) , NORTH , Range TWENTY (20) , WEST , THE SAME BEING THE PLAT OF CARLIN , SAID PLAT BEING OF RECORD IN THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS IN AND FOR ST. LOUIS COUNTY .
