

TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GILBERT
ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The undersigned respectfully set forth to your
Honorable Body the following facts:

That they and each of them are legal voters residing
within the following described territory, situated in the
County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, to wit:

The east 1/2 of Section 27, all of section 28, except
that part included in the corporate limits of the Village
of Gilbert; the West 1/2 of section 29; the North East 1/4
and the North 1/2 of the South East 1/4 of Section 34; the
North 1/2, the North 1/2 of the South West 1/4, and Govern-
ment Lot 2 of section 35; all of said land being situated
in Township 55 North, Range 17 West, St. Louis County, Minnesota

That the boundaries of said territory are as follows:-
Beginning at the North West corner of the North East 1/4 of
Section 27; thence running southerly along the North and South
center line of Section 27 and 28 to the South West corner of
the North 1/2 of South East 1/4 of said Section 34, thence
easterly along the south boundary of the North 1/2 of the South
East 1/4 of said Section 34 to the East line of said Section 34;
thence southerly along the West line of section 35 to its inter-
section with the shore line of Cedar Island Lake; thence North-
easterly along the shore line of Cedar Island Lake by its var-
ious courses and distances to the South boundary line of the
North 1/2 of the South West 1/4 of section 35; thence easterly
along the South boundary line of the North 1/2 of the South
West 1/4 of section 35 to the North and South center line of
said Section 35, thence northerly along said center line to
the center of said Section 35; thence easterly along the East
and West center line of said Section 35 to the East 1/4 corner
of the said Section 35, thence northerly along the East line

of said Section 25 to the Northeast corner of Section 25; thence easterly along the South line of Section 25 to the South 1/4 corner of said Section 25; thence northerly along the North and South center line of Section 25 to the North 1/4 corner of said Section 25; thence westerly ^{along the North line of Section 25} to a point of said North line 314.41 feet easterly from the North 1/4 corner of Section 26, thence ~~South~~ ^{South} westerly in a straight line to a point in the North and South center line of Section 26, 404.65 feet southerly from the North 1/4 Corner of Section 26; thence southerly along the North and South center line of Section 26 to the Northeast corner of the South West 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of said Section 26; thence southwesterly in a straight line to the South West corner of the South West 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of said Section 26; thence northerly along the North and South center line of the North West 1/4 of Section 26 to the North East corner of the North West 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of said Section 26; thence westerly along the North line of Section 26 and 27 to the North West corner of the North East 1/4 of said Section 27, to the place of beginning.

That no part of said territory is included in any existing incorporated city or village; that said territory adjoins the said Village of Gilbert, and that no part of said territory is more than one and one half miles from the present limits of the said Village of Gilbert.

That said territory embraces 1880 acres of land, and has a resident population of not less than seventy five (75) persons, and that the number of actual residents thereon is 590 as has first been duly ascertained by the census taken by and under the direction of the undersigned between the 20th day and 24th day of January 1914, as appears by the verification hereto.

That they, your petitioners herein, desire to have said territory annexed to the said incorporated Village of Gilbert, and have the same become a part thereof and included in said Village, in accordance with Chapter 113 of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1909.

And they, therefore, respectfully petition your Honorable Body to call an election for the determination of said proposed annexation and to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing within said territory may vote for or against such annexation of said territory to the said Village of Gilbert.

Trustee Julius Bordman moved the adoption of the following resolution, to wit:

WHEREAS, The petition for calling an election for the determination of the proposed annexation of the territory hereinafter described having been presented to the Village Council of the Village of Gilbert, St. Louis County, Minnesota on the 27th day of January 1946, and being made to appear that said petition has been properly signed by not less than five legal voters of said State and residing within the territory therein proposed to be annexed into said Village of Gilbert, and,

WHEREAS, It appears by said petition that a census of the resident population of said territory has first been duly taken, and that said territory has a resident population of not less than seventy five persons and that the number of actual residents thereon is 590; that said census was taken within the last past four weeks, and that the boundaries of said territory to be annexed, and the description of the same, are as follows:

The East 1/3 of Section 27, all of Section 28, except that part included in the corporate limits of the Village of Gilbert; the East 1/3 of Section 29; the North East 1/4 and the North 1/3 of the South East 1/4 of Section 34; the North 1/3, the North 1/3 of the South East 1/4, and Government Lot 2 of Section 35; all of said described land being situated in Township 68 North, Range 17 West, County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota. That the boundaries of said territory are as follows:- Beginning at the North West corner of the North East 1/4 of Section 27; thence running southerly along the North and South center line of Section 27 and 28 to the South West corner of the North 1/3 of the South East 1/4 of Section 34; thence easterly along the south boundary of the North 1/3 of the South East 1/4 of said Section 34 to the East line of

said Section 34; thence southerly along the *West* line of Section 35 to its intersection with the shore line of Cedar Island Lake; thence northeasterly along the shore line of the Cedar Island Lake by its various courses and distances to the South boundary line of the North 1/3 of the South West 1/4 of Section 35; thence easterly along the South boundary line of the North 1/3 of the South West 1/4 of Section 35 to the North and South center line of said Section 35, thence northerly along said center line to the center of said Section 35; thence easterly along the East and West center line of said Section 35 to the East 1/4 corner of the said Section 35; thence northerly along the East line of said Section 35 to the North East Corner of Section 35; thence easterly along the South line of Section 35 to the South 1/4 corner of said Section 35; thence northerly along the North and South center line of Section 35 to the North 1/4 corner of said Section 35; *thence westerly along the North line of Section 35 to a point on said North line 314.61 feet easterly from the North 1/4* corner of Section 35, thence Southwesterly in a straight line to a point on the North and South center line of Section 36, 483.65 feet southerly from the North 1/4 Corner of Section 36; thence southerly along the said North and South center line of Section 36 to the Northeast corner of the South West 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of said Section 36; thence southwesterly in a straight line to the South West Corner of the South East 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of the said Section 36; thence northerly along the North and South center line of the North West 1/4 of Section 36 to the North East corner of the North West 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of said Section 36; thence westerly along the North line of Sections 36 and 37 to the North West corner of the North East 1/4 of said Section 37, to the place of Beginning.
