

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE
ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TER-
RITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF
SPRING PARK, MINN.

Section 1. Annexation

That the land hereinafter de-
scribed in Section 2 hereof, the
Village Council having determin-
ed that the annexation thereof is
to the best interests of the vil-
lage and of the territory affected,
is hereby annexed to and includ-
ed within the boundaries of the
Village of Spring Park, pursu-
ant to a petition by the sole
owner of said land which is ad-
jacent to present Spring Park
Village limits in accordance with
Minnesota Statutes Section
412.041, Subd 4.

Lot belonging to Harlan Town-
er which is described as part of
Lot 10, Block 10, Townsite of
Langdon Park.

ORDINANCE NO. 13

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF SPRING PARK, MINN.

The Village Council of the Village of Spring Park ordains:

Section 1. Annexation

That the land hereinafter described in Section 2 hereof, the Village Council having determined that the annexation thereof is to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected, is hereby annexed to and included within the boundaries of the Village of Spring Park, pursuant to a petition of a majority of the owners of said land and after a hearing on said petition in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Section 412.041, Subd. 4.

Section 2. Description of land annexed.

That land lying east and south of present easterly village limits of the Village of Spring Park as follows: Lots 1, 2 and 3, Streater's Spring Park Addition, Block 4; lots 1, 2 and 3, Streater's Spring Park Addition, Block 5, together with unnumbered lot directly east of above mentioned lots and joined on the east by lots 1 and 2, Townsite of Langdon Park, Block 9, and including lots 1 and 2, Block 9; Lots 1 through 12, Townsite of Langdon Park, Block 8, and Lots 1 and 2, Townsite of Langdon Park, block 7.

Section 3. Certified Copies to be Filed.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Auditor of Hennepin County, Minnesota, and a certified copy thereof with the office of the Secretary of State of Minnesota.

Section 4. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and the filing of said certified copies as aforesaid.
