

ORDINANCE NO. 1.09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE JURISDICTION OF CERTAIN
TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGES OF DEEPHAVEN

The Village Council of the Village of Deephaven, ordains:

SECTION I. PURPOSE.

That the land hereafter described in Section II hereof, the Village Council having determined that the annexation thereof is to the best interests of the village and to the territory affected, is hereby annexed to and included within the boundaries of the Village of Deephaven pursuant to a petition of all of the owners of said land and after considering the matter, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 413.022 sub 4.

SECTION II. DESCRIPTION OF LAND ANNEXED.

Lot 19, Auditor's subdivision Number 142, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

SECTION III. CERTIFIED COPIES TO BE FILED.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Auditor of Hennepin County, Minnesota, and a certified copy thereof with the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and the filing of said certified copies as aforesaid.


