A Proclamation for "United States Air Force Recruiting Week"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period beginning February 1, 1955, and ending February 6, 1955, as

UNITED STATES AIR FORCE RECRUITING WEEK in Minnesota

and urge all citizens of the state to give due attention and recognition to the program of the United States Air Force.
