A Proclamation for "YMCA Week"


WHEREAS, the Young Men's Christian Association, through its program to develop spirit, mind and body has made a real contribution to the people of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, its physical, educational and social activities contribute materially to the development of good health, useful lives, and responsible citizenship; and


WHEREAS, its religious principles foster clean living, faith in God, and adherence to the golden rule;
