Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Fifty-eight  
(58) North, Range Twenty (20) West, St. Louis  
County, Minnesota.

This is a continuation of the appointment made by Honorable J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General, on March 24, 1954. The appointee will serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this commission is revoked.

All costs and expenses of such proceedings, including compensation of the Special Assistant Attorney General hereby appointed, shall be paid by the lessee named in Iron Ore Mining Lease No. I-5017.


