A Proclamation for "Grandly Our Freedom Day"

WHEREAS, it offers an opportunity for all Americans to join an effective organization toward the victory of the principles in which we believe in the struggle for the peace and freedom of man;
NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRITTON B. BOVEN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 22-28, 1955 as

"GRANDLY OUR FREEDOM DAY"

and urge all citizens to consider the importance of the week and to give all possible encouragement to the activities and goals of the Grandly Our Freedom Day.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed on the State Capitol at St. Paul, this tenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five and of the State the sixteenth.
