A Proclamation for "University of Minnesota Week"

WHEREAS, it is of vital importance to the future of the University and to the continued and ever-increasing contributions which the University of Minnesota makes to all aspects of our life that citizens of this state should recognize their value;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of February 21-26, 1955, as

"UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA WEEK"

and urge all citizens to note the many contributions of the University to our State and to give to the University due recognition and support.
