The compensation and the payment of expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of his duties shall continue until otherwise determined, but said compensation and payment of expenses shall not exceed Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) during any fiscal year.

Any written legal opinion rendered by said Special Assistant must be released through the office of Attorney General, and any court action or proceeding in which such Special Assistant is to appear must first be approved by the Attorney General.
