OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

WHEREAS the Minnesota State Board of Pharmacy (herein called "the Board") has in writing dated February 4, 1955, requested the Attorney General to cause to be instituted appropriate legal proceedings against Red Owl Incorporated and also against Groves-Kelco Incorporated for alleged violations of the State Pharmacy Act and that a Special Assistant Attorney General be appointed to the Board to bring the necessary actions and to advise the Board in relation thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, MILES LORD, ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, do hereby constitute and appoint WILLIAM W. ESSLING, of Saint Paul, Minnesota, to act as Special Assistant Attorney General for the State of Minnesota to institute the necessary actions and to advise the Board in respect thereof and to appear for and in behalf of the Board and the State of Minnesota in such actions or any or either of them and to handle, conduct, and manage such litigation for the purposes aforesaid. His compensation therefor is hereby fixed at the sum of Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) per day for services in the preparation for court proceedings in the litigation and Sixty-five Dollars (\$65.00) per day when appearing in court in connection with the litigation; such compensation to be paid out of funds of the Board upon verified claims therefor presented to the Board by the appointee and by the Board allowed. The compensation so fixed shall continue until otherwise determined. Said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.




