Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the
authority vested in me by law, and at the request of the
Minnesota State Board of Optometry, do hereby constitute and
appoint

RICHARD W. JOHNSON

of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General
to act for the said Minnesota State Board of Optometry. His
compensation shall be paid from and out of the funds of said
Board and is hereby fixed as follows: For such part time as
the Board may require, but not to exceed one-twelfth of his
full time, the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month, and
for such time as the Board may require in excess of such part
time for office services at the rate of Thirty-five Dollars
(\$35.00) per day, and for services in court at the rate of
Sixty-five Dollars (\$65.00) per day.


